

## SENATE

**2. Presidential Opposition.** Percentage of recorded votes cast in 2012 on which the president took a position and on which the senator voted “yea” or “nay” in disagreement with the president’s position. Failure to vote does not lower an individual’s score.

**3. Participation in Presidential Support Votes.** Percentage of recorded votes in 2012 on which the president took a position and for which the senator was eligible and present and voted “yea” or “nay.” There were a total of 79 such recorded votes in the Senate.

<sup>1</sup>Ron Barber, D-Ariz., was sworn in June 19, 2012, to fill the vacancy created by the Jan. 25 resignation of fellow Democrat Gabrielle Giffords. Giffords was eligible for one presidential support vote in 2012; Barber was eligible for 28 presidential support votes.

<sup>2</sup>Dennis Cardoza, D-Calif., resigned Aug. 15, 2012. The last vote for which he was eligible was vote 556. Cardoza was eligible for 51 presidential support votes in 2012.

<sup>3</sup>Bob Filner, D-Calif., resigned Dec. 3, 2012. The last vote for which he was eligible was vote 613. Filner was eligible for 58 presidential support votes in 2012.

<sup>4</sup>Jesse L. Jackson Jr, D-Ill., resigned Nov. 21, 2012. The last vote for which he was eligible was vote 608. Jackson was eligible for 57 presidential support votes in 2012.

<sup>5</sup>Thomas Massie, R-Ky., was sworn in Nov. 13, 2012, to fill the vacancy created by the July 31 resignation of fellow Republican Geoff Davis. Davis was eligible for 49 presidential support votes in 2012; Massie was eligible for 5 presidential support votes.

<sup>6</sup>David A. Curson, D-Mich., was sworn in Nov. 13, 2012, to fill the vacancy created by the July 6 resignation of Republican Thaddeus McCotter. McCotter was eligible for 38 presidential support votes in 2012; Curson was eligible for five presidential support votes.

<sup>7</sup>Donald M. Payne Jr, D-N.J., was sworn in Nov. 15, 2012, to fill the vacancy created by the March 6 death of his father, fellow Democrat Donald M. Payne. The elder Payne was eligible for eight presidential support votes in 2012; Payne Jr. was eligible for five presidential support votes.

<sup>8</sup>The speaker votes only at his discretion.

<sup>9</sup>Suzanne Bonamici, D-Ore., was sworn in Feb. 7, 2012, to fill the vacancy created by the Aug. 3, 2011, resignation of fellow Democrat David Wu. Bonamici was eligible for 59 presidential support votes in 2012. (Wu was not eligible for any votes in 2012.)

<sup>10</sup>Suzan DelBene, D-Wash., was sworn in Nov. 13, 2012, to fill the vacancy created by the March 20 resignation of fellow Democrat Jay Inslee. Inslee was eligible for nine presidential support votes in 2012; DelBene was eligible for five presidential support votes.
