**38. S 951. Department of Justice Authorization, Fiscal 1982.** Heflin, D-Ala., amendment to allow the Department of Justice to participate in legal proceedings to remove or reduce the requirement of busing in existing court orders. Adopted 72-22: R 35-12; D 37-10 (ND 22-10, SD 15-0), March 2, 1982.

**39. S 951. Department of Justice Authorization, Fiscal 1982.** Passage of the bill to authorize funds for Department of Justice programs; to bar federal courts from ordering students bused more than five miles or 15 minutes from their homes; and to bar the Department of Justice from participating in busing litigation unless it is to reduce or remove busing requirements from existing court orders. Passed 57-37: R 34-13; D 23-24 (ND 9-23, SD 14-1), March 2, 1982.

**40. Theberge Nomination.** Confirmation of President Reagan's nomination of James Daniel Theberge to be U.S. ambassador

to Chile. Confirmed 83-12: R 47-1; D 36-11 (ND 23-9, SD 13-2), March 2, 1982. A "yea" was a vote supporting the president's position.

**41. S Res 330. Martial Law in Poland.** Adoption of the resolution to call for the release by Poland's military government of Lech Walesa, leader of the Polish independent trade union federation Solidarity, held in detention since the imposition of martial law in that nation Dec. 13, 1981. Adopted 94-0: R 47-0; D 47-0 (ND 32-0, SD 15-0), March 2, 1982.

**42. S 1503. Standby Petroleum Allocation Act.** Adoption of the conference report on the bill to authorize the president to allocate petroleum supplies in a severe shortage. Adopted 86-7: R 41-6; D 45-1 (ND 30-1, SD 15-0), March 2, 1982. A "nay" was a vote supporting the president's position.
